Radon Jingle for grade school students For use with children up to age 10 or in 5th grade

- Radon's a colorless, odorless gas
- Test your house to see if you pass
- Radon travels through the ground
- You can't hear it: it makes no sound
- ■Basement, crawlspace, slab on grade,
- •Mitigated radon is cool as shade!

Radon's a colorless, ordorless gas (Snap fingers to the beat)
Test your house to see if you pass (Snap fingers to the beat)
Radon travels through the ground (Put hands together and make back & forth motion like a river)

You can't hear it, it makes no sound (Put hands by ears)
Basement, crawlspace, slab-on-grade (Touch floor for basement, touch knees for crawl space, put hands out for slab on grade)
Mitigated radon is cool as shade! (Put hands together for mitigated radon. Then put hands overhead and wiggle fingers for cool as shade, like shade trees.)
